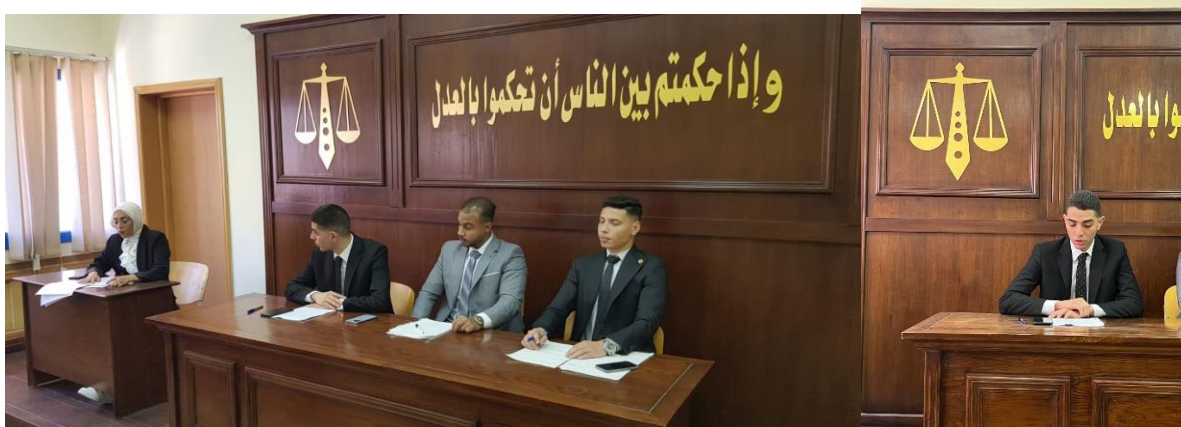
ICJ's Mock Trial

Posted On: May 29, 2024

The Public International Law Department at PUA's Faculty of Legal Studies and International Relations organized a mock trial for South Africa's lawsuit before the International Court of Justice. This activity was designed to train students in pleading skills before international courts, which have the authority to consider cases referred by parties, as well as issues specifically outlined in the Charter of the United Nations, applicable treaties, and agreements.

The mock trial provided an immersive learning experience where students engaged in realistic legal proceedings. The department also facilitated practical training sessions at its Courtroom, simulating the structure and procedures of a mock trial before the judges of the International Court of Justice. During these sessions, students took on the roles of various international parties involved in the trial.

A mock session was held where the arguments of the teams representing both sides were presented. This exercise not only enhanced the students' legal knowledge but also honed their practical skills in international law, preparing them for future careers in the field.





Art Therapy Workshop Posted On: October 28, 2024

As part of PUA's student activities program, the Faculty of Arts and Design organized a workshop titled "Art Therapy." The workshop featured Dr. Basant Khalil, a psychologist and art therapist with multiple international certifications, who introduced students to art therapy as a therapeutic method. 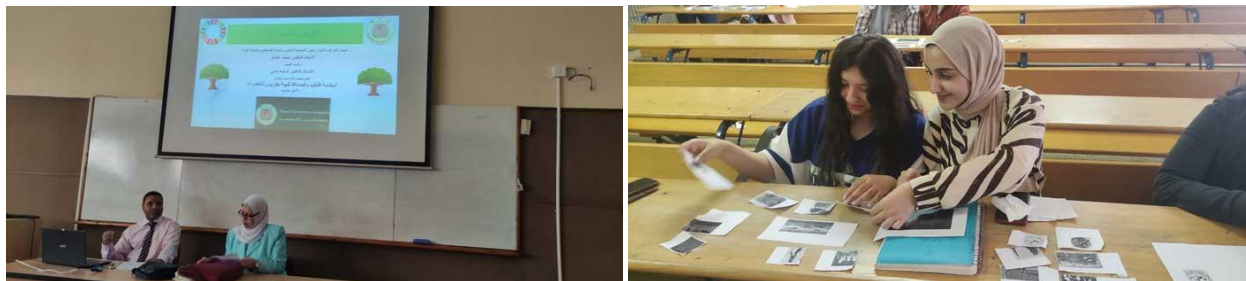
Education Sustainability and Environmental Consciousness Workshop Posted On : May 8, 2024

Under the esteemed patronage of Prof. Dr. Mohamed Etman, Vice President for Community Service and Development Affairs, and Prof. Dr. Osama Madani, Dean of the Faculty of Languages and Translation, Dr. Al-Sayed Hassouna from the Spanish Language Department led a seminar and workshop focusing on education sustainability and environmental consciousness as part of the Pharos Green Initiative.

The seminar aimed to raise awareness about sustainability in education and promote the green initiatives undertaken by Pharos University. Dr. Hassouna elaborated on the comprehensive approach and prerequisites of sustainable development, emphasizing the imperative of meeting present needs without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their own requirements.

Furthermore, the seminar featured visual representations of global challenges, encompassing issues such as poverty, inequality, climate change, environmental degradation, prosperity, peace, and justice. Dr. Hassouna outlined seventeen goals aimed at addressing these challenges, aligning with the United Nations' framework, with a particular emphasis on the fourth goal—quality education as a means to achieve sustainable development. He commended the pivotal role played by government officials and personnel across various sectors in implementing this methodology.

In the workshop's culmination, participants deliberated on existing challenges and obstacles, identifying corrective measures necessary to realize all sustainable development goals by 2030.





Virtual Reality in Molecular Modeling Workshop

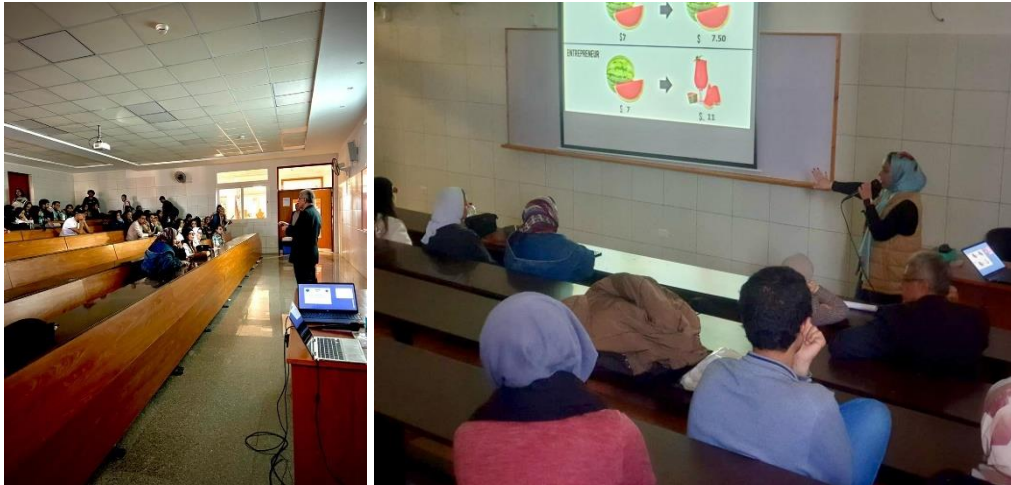

Faculty members and their collaborators, the Egyptian Knowledge Bank, in collaboration with the Science, Technology and Innovation Finance Authority (STDF) and SpringerNature Research Academies, announces the opening of training workshops to help Egyptian researchers write project proposals, publish their research findings in peer-reviewed journals, and enhance their research skills.



The program consists of 63 interactive remote workshops divided into three main workshops:

- 1- "Writing a paper", through which professional writing strategies will be discussed to clearly communicate the relevance and relevance of the study from the researcher to the reader through the paper presented.
- 2- "Research methodology" will address the steps to be taken in planning a new study to ensure that it is vigorously conducted to generate valid and documented results.
- 3- "Writing a project proposal" will help researchers to learn about modern funding methods and write an effective proposal to request the grant for successful research funding.
