


A Group Breakfast at PUA's Arts and Design Posted On: November 19, 2023

The Community Service and Environmental Development Committee at the Faculty of Applied Health Sciences Technology launched a charity convoy for El Hana Nursing Home for elderly women.



Arts and Design's Annual Charity Market Posted On: April 2, 2024


